

Concepts About Print Lesson:

Print is All Around Us

Why This Lesson Is Important

Print is all around us. Children need to learn to differentiate print from pictures and other objects.

Preparation

- Find the Concepts About Print book “Print Is All Around Us.”

Direct Teaching Lesson

(5 minutes)

1. Read the book aloud to the children.
2. Point out the print in the book.
3. Encourage the children to find print in the environment. Look in the places mentioned in the book.

Note

- The object of this activity is to notice the print. You do not need to focus on reading all of the print that you find.

Practice Throughout Your Day

- Look for print as you go different places--when you are in the car, at the store, at the library, etc. Find letters on signs, labels, junk mail, people's shirts, etc.
